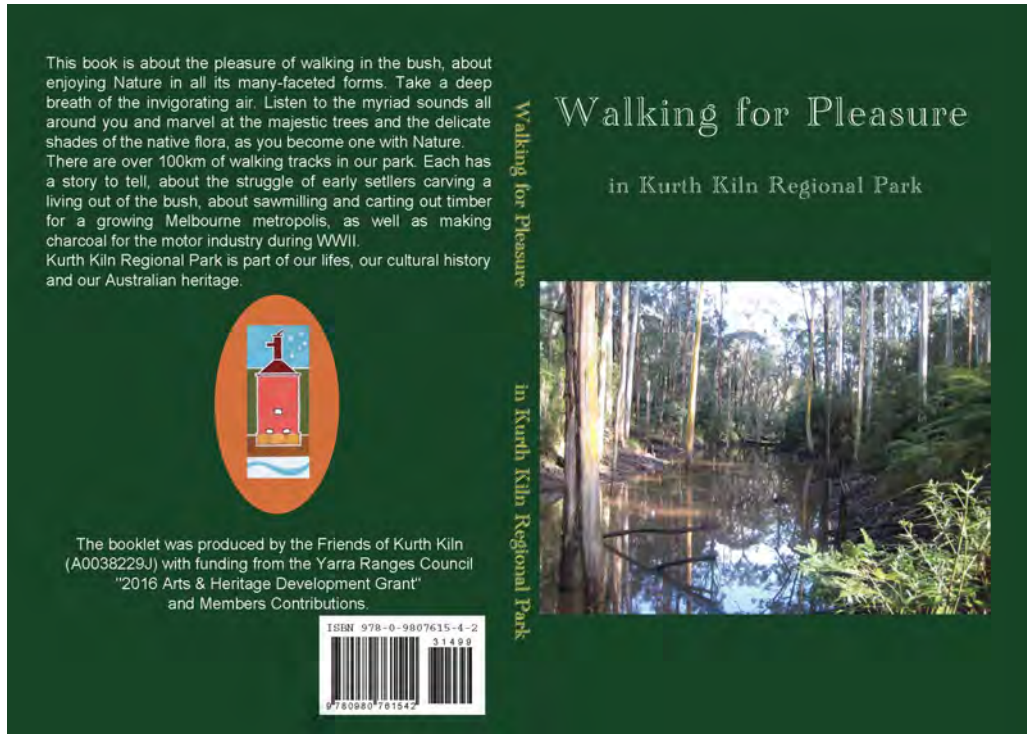


Friends of Kurth Kiln Meeting and Working Bee
