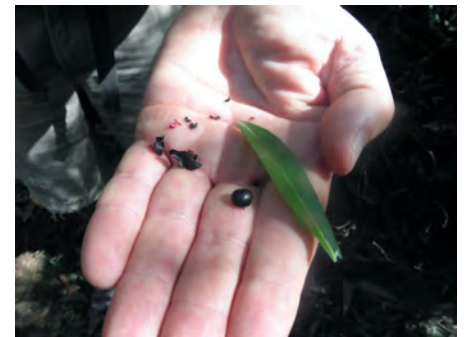


# A morning walk with Cr Mayor Brett Owen, from the Cardinia Shire Council Wednesday 15 March 2017
