  - a. Vivien Clarke, who supplied us with seedlings for revegetation projects advised that she would retire at the end of the year.
  - b. The Friends of Hoddles Creek informative talk on invertebrates and biological diversity held at Hoddles Creek was attended by five Friends of Kurth Kiln members.
  - c. Alfred completed the National Trust Victoria Festival Survey and thanked them for promoting the Kurth Kiln Heritage Festival.
  - d. Jasper reported about his Greater Glider work at the Two Dams area
  - e. Laurence reported about the Sherbrooke Amphipod that has recently been found in the Kurth Kiln Regional Park
  - f. Thank you cards were sent to the Victorian National Park Association visit and the Waverley Bushwalking Club for their donations.

## 4. FINANCIAL

- a. The Treasurer, Henriëtte, was unable to attend the meeting.
  - i. Alfred passed around a copy of the Bendigo Bank Statement covering activities over the months of April and May. Festival expenses were:
    - (1) \$800 for Food Vouchers has been paid to the Hoddles Creek Red Cross group
    - (2) \$709 for Generator and Toilets to Kennards Hire
    - (3) \$330 for Traffic Management to ATM
  - ii. \$286 was paid to Mountain Gate Plumbing for gas line repair in Caretakers Hut
  - iii. Petty Cash received as donations and for books to be sorted out with Henriëtte.

## 5. General Business

- a. The Heritage Festival in April was held in a reduced format due to heavy rain and winds and many cancellations. Concentrated under the roof of the Big Shed, with the Red Cross catering for food and drinks, and the lively music of the band, it became a friendly family type event.
- b. Parks Victorias 2017 Volunteer Recognition Day at the Melbourne Zoo on Saturday May 13, was held on a beautiful sunny day, and ten members of Friends of Kurth Kiln attended.
- c. Funding Grants have been applied for:
  - The Shiprock Falls 2000 plants revegetation grant has been reapplied to DELWP for \$8,140, to be managed in two sessions, September 2017 and March 2018.
  - ii. A Heritage Festival Grant has again been applied to Cardinia Council for \$2150 for 8 April
- d. Grant projects proposed:
  - i. A proposal was made to create a 2018/19 Kurth Kiln Heritage Calendar, with photos of the construction of the Kiln in 1941, and of the huts dating back to the early 1980's.
  - ii. The Kurth Kiln promotional pamphlet needs a reprint, including some updated information.
- e. The Department of Social Services grant 4-37M4SD2 of \$4,262.00 received in June last year, has now been completed. The Defibrillator and three First Aid kits, were purchased from St John Ambulance Australia. Alfred to complete the Acquittal Form
  - i. Rozz has volunteered to organise a combined training session for the 10 volunteers
- f. Glen needed \$40 for some maintenance and gas bottle refill expenses.
- g. The Parks Victoria VAP plan was signed and returned to Rozz.
