 - a. Present:

 - b. Apologies: Matthew, Jan, Ron, Tyrone
- 2. Previous Minutes: The Minutes of the February meeting were accepted as is.
- 3. Correspondence: highlighted items discussed were
 - a. Gembrook Market to be held in Gembrook Community Hall in future.
 - b. Cardinia Festival Remittance for \$2,150.00 has been received.
 - c. Melbourne Water Community Grant for \$1100.00 has been received
 - d. Laurence spoke about the proposed State Government Riparian Revegetation Restrictions in the Yarra Valley, to restrict Stream Frontage revegetation to a maximum distance of 10 metres in the riparian areas around Launching Place and Yarra Junction.
 - i. Jasper suggested the Friends of Kurth Kiln support Laurence's submission for more research to be undertaken. A vote was taken, all in favour.
 - e. Sally Mc Donald would like to join our group. She will attend our next meeting in April
 - f. Julie Konda from the FESTIVE TRIBE Group asked if they could take part in the Heritage Festival with kids entertainment. An invitation to attend this meeting was not followed up
 - g. Our Cardinia Council Festival Funding Application for 2018 has been submitted

4. FINANCIAL

- a. The Treasurer, Henriëtte, presented a current Financial Statement (see attached)
- b. Alfred spoke of the difficulties our present "two signature cheque" arrangement creates for effective management of the group:
 - i. Travelling long distances to hunt for a second signatory
 - ii. Missing the convenience of Credit Card purchases, unable to do on-the-spot purchases
 - iii. Unable to make use of efficient Internet Banking
- c. Considering this, Alfred moved a motion to apply to the Bendigo Bank for Single Signature authorisation for all the present registered signatories to the Friends of Kurth Kiln Account:
 - i. Henriëtte van Niekerk, Craig Bankowski and Alfred Klink
 - ii. The motion was duly seconded by Henriëtte and carried unanimously.

5. **General Business**

- a. Glen reported on recent vandal damage on the site: (Gembrook Office has been advised)
 - i. Cladding ripped from the back of Annexe 04 has since been repaired, replaced
 - ii. Damage to the Caretaker Hut Water Tank and Stand. Unfortunately the tank may have to be welded, soldered or bronzed to make it watertight again. It is now empty
 - (1) Rodney said he would check if it can be repaired "in house"
 - iii. Our Black Marquee seems to have disappeared about two weeks ago
- b. Termite Problem. All sheds are to be sprayed after the festival for termites and other pests
 - i. A follow up treatment is required some six months later.
- c. Rodney was thanked for cutting fence posts for replacements and repair on the Northern Picnic Area Fence and the Waterwheel Lake Railings
- d. Henriëtte inquired about the possibility of grading the roads for pot holes etc..
 - i. Rozz responded saying Parks will try and fill in some of the holes in the roads.
- e. Festival
 - i. Ian advised that the Red Cross will set up on Saturday 8 April. They will bring enough water for their coffee machine. If needed, there is also water in the tank behind the kiln.
 - ii. Rozz reminded everyone that permits are required for festival stall holders.
 - iii. Gas is required to in the Caretaker Hut to heat water for the festival
 - iv. Members please bring a cake or slice for the volunteers coffee in the Caretaker Hut.
 - v. The Friends of Kurth Kiln will supply approximately 80 food vouchers for the participants
 - vi. Some 70 copies of the festival Flyer were passed around for distribution
