

Meeting and Working Bee Saturday 9 April



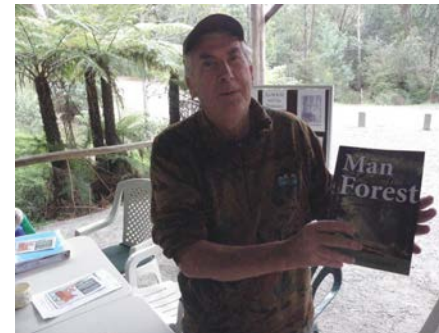
