The slower group will walk from the kiln site through the camping ground to the Waterchannel Track, stopping on the way to look at the interpretation panel and at the sites where the waterchannel can still be seen. On their return to Kurth Kiln they will go via the Thornton Track, again stopping to look at the six interpretation panels on the way..

Both groups will have lunch at the Kiln site and Alfred will give a talk about the history of the kiln site.
